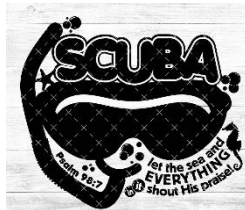

Kroger Community Rewards Program

Kenova UMC recently enrolled in Kroger’s Community Reward Program. The program makes fundraising easy by donating to local organizations based on the shopping you do every day. Once you link your Kroger card to an organization all you need to do is shop at Kroger’s and swipe your Shopper’s Card. Here is how it works:

1. Create a digital account if you have not already done so by visiting <http://www.kroger.com>. New users will need to create an account which requires some basic information, a valid email address and a rewards card.
2. Once you have logged into your Kroger account you can search for **Kenova United Methodist Church either by name or TU238** and then click enroll and then click save.
3. Any transactions moving forward using the Shopper’s Card Number associated with your digital account will be applied to the program, at no added cost to you. Kroger donates to participating organizations based on your percentage of spending as it relates to the total spending associated with all participating Kroger Community Rewards organizations. Participants must swipe their registered Kroger rewards card or use the phone number that is related to their registered Kroger rewards card when shopping for each purchase to count.

*If you do not have a Kroger rewards card, the cards are available at the customer service desk at any Kroger.

** Each account holder will have to re-enroll their Kroger Plus Card on an annual basis.
